Junior Dressage Championship Classes First Round

Class 1 The Great Midland Junior Intro Championship First Round (to include lead rein)

Test: Intro B 2009 Entry fee £20.00 Prize Money 1st £25, 2nd £10, 3rd £8.

Class 2 The Great Midland Junior Prelim Championship First Round

Test: Prelim 12 2005 Entry fee £20.00 Prize Money 1st £25, 2nd £10, 3rd £8.

Class 3 The Great Midland Junior Novice Championship First Round

Test: Novice 24 2010 Entry fee £20.00 Prize Money 1st £25, 2nd £10, 3rd £8.

Junior classes on Saturday are allowed callers & whips

Please note: Everyone competes both days. Day one we will be awarding rosettes from 1st – 10th in all classes. 1st place will also be awarded a sash. Day two we will be awarding rosettes from 1st-10th place in all classes. 1st place will also be awarded a sash and trophy. We will also be awarding the champion of each level; adding together the Saturday and Sunday percentage to work this out. The highest combined percentage over the two days will be awarded champion at that level.

Closing date for dressage entries? All dressage classes must be pre entered and entries must be received by Thursday 6th September 2018.

When and how will I get my dressage times & bridle number? Dressage times & bridle numbers for Saturday 8th & Sunday 9th September will be released on Thursday 6th September 2018 at 1pm and will be visible on www.greatmidlandshorshow.com on the times page.

Am I allowed a whip & caller? GMHS are allowing whips and callers in all dressage classes.

Will dressage classes be on a surface? Yes all dressage classes will be held on surface arenas.

Can I stable at Onley Grounds & how do I book? To book stable please call Onley Grounds office on 01788 817724 open Monday-Friday 9-5pm. Payment will be taken over the phone at time of booking.

Can I take part in any other disciplines at GMHS Championships if I haven't pre-qualified? Showing classes on Saturday 8th September are open to non-qualified combinations. If you have not pre-qualified for any showing classes and you compete on Saturday 8th September and place 1st-3rd, you will be eligible to compete on Sunday 9th September. You only need to qualify in one showing class to be

eligible to enter any showing class on Sunday 9th September. All show jumping classes must be pre-qualified & pre entered.
